English

We will be reading a novel closely tied with our topic called Marcie and the Riddle of the Sphynx. The pupils will be focusing on the composition and punctuation of a variety of writing genres starting with a playscript.

<u>History</u>

In History, we will be looking at Egyptian explorers, how the Egyptians live as well as their beliefs and how they changed over time.

Geography

The focus of the term is Rivers. We will be looking at famous rivers around the world, how rivers shape land and how they change over time.

Art and Design

The focus this term is sculpture. We will be looking at the shapes of sculptures, how they are made and designing our own Egyptian sculpture.

Our topic this term is People of God. The children will think about different ways that some Christians worship God. We will read several parables to consolidate our learning.

Science

This term in Science we will be learning about rocks. The children will learn about different types of rocks and how they are formed. Later in the term, the children will explore different fossils and soils as well as investigating how permeable different rocks and soils are.

Music

We will learn to play the chime bars.

Maths

Place value will be our first topic of the term. The children will consolidate representing and partitioning numbers, moving on to numbers to 1000. We will then move on to addition and subtraction of three digit numbers.

Latin

This year the pupils will be introduced to Latin! We will begin this exciting topic learning greetings and family names as we are introduced to our Roman family from Vindalonda.

RHE

Our focus in RHE is Families and People Who Care for Me. The children will think about the different ways to care for one another, focusing on positive friendships

Computing

In Computing we will be coding using the Purple Mash Computing Program.
